



WASC Affiliation Conditions of Eligibility for Postsecondary Title IV Institutions

All organizations to be considered for WASC affiliation must meet the conditions listed below. Applicants will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis in determining eligibility.

1. Be in operation, with students, teachers and administration in place.
2. Have developed and published a clear statement of purposes together with plans for a curriculum to carry out those purposes.
3. Have a properly functioning governing board.
4. Have employed a chief administrative officer who is qualified for the position.
5. Have an organization, facilities, course offerings, and staffing acceptable for the institution's stage of development.
6. Have an institutional plan including objectives for student achievement and assessment plans to measure progress toward those objectives.
7. Have an admissions policy compatible with the institution's stated objectives.
8. Offer instruction in all subject areas required to meet the institution's stated purpose.
9. Have a written sequential curriculum appropriate to the institution's purpose.
10. Have a qualified instructional staff.
11. Have developed an adequate financial base to give reasonable assurance of continuing financial stability.
12. Have developed a plan to meet Federal Title IV requirements within a three-year period.
